

Chapter 5 Scene Creation

- 100 points

-You will be assigned a person/concept from Chapter 5 about which you and your team are assigned to create a scene:

Requirements:

This scene needs to:

- highlight the important details of the person/concept as reported in *History Alive*.
- enlighten the class about your person/concept – teach us something new
- incorporate every single group member’s summary comment or question that was made which pertains to your person/concept
- utilize ALL members of your group** – if you don’t need all members to ACT in the scene, certainly props, music, and research are important roles
- be as creative as possible
- include some kind of music or song, if possible
- last somewhere between 2-4 minutes.

Process:

- You will have part of the period on Monday and Tuesday to plan.
- You can communicate via email or phone in the evening to fine-tune your scene’s vision. There is no need to get together outside of class to prepare for this.
- Members of each group will receive the same grade, which will be based on the aforementioned requirements.
- You will present these on Wednesday in class. If someone is absent, s/he is expected to communicate his/her absence ahead of time to the group to give them a heads-up, otherwise, that person will receive a “0” and the group will still need to perform its scene.
- After the groups perform their scenes, every one of you will write your own paragraph explaining the process you underwent to accomplish the creation of your scene. You will also detail how each member of the group contributed to the final outcome.
